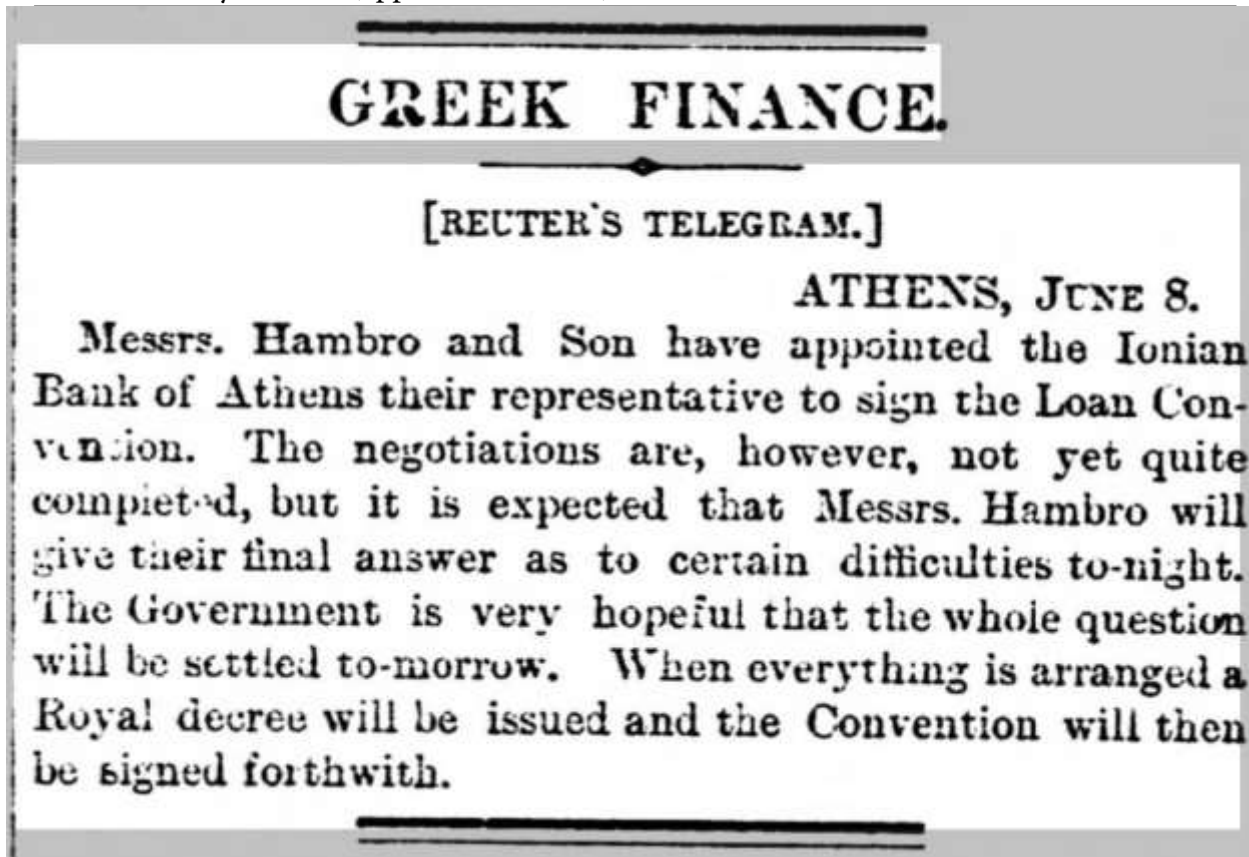

TRANSCRIPTION

GREEK FINANCE.

[REUTERS TELEGRAM.]

ATHENS, JUNE 8. [1893]

Messrs. Hambro and Son have appointed the Ionian Bank of Athens their representative to sign the Loan Convention. The negotiations are, however, not yet quite completed, but it is expected that Messrs. Hambro will give their final answer as to certain difficulties to-night. The Government is very hopeful that the whole question will be settled to-morrow. When everything is arranged a Royal decree will be issued and the Convention will then be signed forthwith.
