## Schafers chosen Baron, Baroness

Anyone familiar with Harold and Sheila Schaffer have no problem understanding why the two were picked as the 1990 Baron and Baroness of Bismarck Folkfest.

As the back chairman of Folkfest explains, a couple chosen for the honor must be two people "who have committed their time and resources to making Bismarck a better community and to Bismarck's success."

When Harold and Sheila shared the "You're the Winner" Award at the 1989 Bismarck Folkfest, Harold's distinguished service record in 1981, it was said, "Both Harold and Sheila have achieved great success in the West for the open-minded spirit and broadening scope of their philanthropy."

Harold Schaffer seems like a natural for the Folkfest honor. After growing up as an impoverished but hard-working North Dakota boy, Schaffer struck it rich selling a product he named Glass Wax in the 1960s. It was the cornerstone of the Gold Seal Co., which he founded in Bismarck and later moved to Arwick Industries in 1981.

It was soon North Dakota's largest home-owned business. After becoming a millionaire, Schaffer moved back to Bismarck to help set the donated land for Bismarck State College and put about 50 students — before his own — through college. He helped pay nursing home bills and hospital bills for the needy. He paid for the floor and other items when the Bismarck Civic Center was built. He's given money to numerous colleges, hospitals, churches and other organizations.

"This has been done not in a way where he's done big, flashy things that get a lot of publicity," said Dennis Sorenson, a former mayor. "Sorenson explained a few years ago that Klippe, a former partner of Schaffer's, once said, 'I've earned hard keeping Harold rich because he was forever giving away the company profits to some-'

The Schafers also put Motors on the map as a business attraction when Gold Seal bought much of the near-downtown area in the 1960s and developed it. In 1980, at the end of selling the Gold Seal Co., Schaffer started the Bismarck-Joseph Motors Foundation and put computer stock into the foundation to ensure that the project would outlive him.

In 1975, Schaffer received the North Dakota Distinguished Award, the state's highest civilian honor.
