			The cipher key for the discussions in the autumn of 1789 was transmitted in Dorchester to Grenville, 28 Oct. 1789, marked "Private, "PRO: CO 42/66, f. 245, 247. The most important individuals in this list, excepting Washington with whom Beckwith exchanged two unimportant remarks, were William Samuel Johnson (No. 1), Philip Schuyler (No. 2), "A Gentleman in Office of the United States," who can only havebeen Henry Knox (No. 4), and Alexander Hamilton (No. 7). The cipher key for seven additional names of persons consulted in the spring of 1790 was enclosed in Dorchester to Grenville, 7 June 1790, marked "Private," PRO: CO 42/68, f. 229, 231. The principal persons in this group were William Paterson, Senator from New Jersey (No. 10), John Jay (No. 12), and Thomas Scott, "Member of House of Representatives from Counties West of Allegheny Mountains" (No. 14). The cipher key for six further names was transmitted in Dorchester to Grenville, 25 Sep. 1790, marked "Private," PRO: CO 42/46, f. 384, 385. The principal informants of Beckwith in this group were Fisher Ames (No. 17), Richard Henry Lee (No. 18), and Isaac Sherman (No. 21). The entire list is printed in Brymner, Report, 1890, p. xli, xlii, consisting of twenty-three names.
